Mike Burke leads a diverse team of professionals and staff functions associated with U.S. Army AH-64 Apache and AH-6 attack/reconnaissance helicopter business opportunities. His role includes strategic business planning, budgeting and allocating new business funds, as well as communicating with domestic and international customers.

Before joining Boeing, Burke was responsible for directing International Business Development activities for Lockheed Martin's current and future Apache Weapons Systems, such as M-TADS/PNVIS, the Fire Control Radar, the Longbow and Hellfire missiles, and the Hellfire Launcher.

Burke served in the U.S. Army for 33 years before retiring as a Brigadier General. He commanded units at nearly every echelon of the Army, including Aviation Brigade Commander in Germany and in the first Gulf War. He also served as Chief of Staff of the Army's III Corps at Fort Hood, Texas; Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics at NATO's LANDSOUTH headquarters in Verona, Italy; Deputy Commanding General of the U.S. Army Aviation Warfighting Center at Fort Rucker, Ala; and Commanding General of the U.S. Army Safety Center, also at Fort Rucker.

Burke holds a bachelor's degree in business from the University of Tampa, Fla.
