Minutes of the November 9, 2013 General Meeting, AZ Chapter MOAA

Introduction of Our Guest Speaker: John Ady gave a brief intro of our illustrious speaker Dr Alexander White, MD. We are honored to have Dr White with us today to share a (small) portion of his life's exploits.

Dr White is a Polish Holocaust survivor, a member of the famous Schindler's List. He survived the war while 34 members of his family did not. After the war he attended medical school in Munich, moved to the U.S. and joined the U S Army Medical Corps. After leaving the Army he became an associate professor of medicine at the Chicago Medical School and practiced there for 40 years. He is now retired and living in Scottsdale. Dr White is a published author of his holocaust memoirs and shares his experiences, both good and bad, with a first hand glimpse into the true evil of a small portion of society. It should be mentioned that Dr White has long lived up to his father's admonition to "Be a Mensch"!
