Summer Fun with the Arizona Chapter

Activity #1

Scottsdale Museum of the West

We have an opportunity to tour the area's newest museum, Scottsdale's Museum of the West, on Friday, July 17. It's entirely new, having opened in January, with great exhibits that tell the story of the Old West through artwork, sculptures and artifacts.

Here are the details:

Where: The museum is located at 3830 N. Marshall Way in the heart of Old Scottsdale with FREE covered parking next door.

Time: Meet at the reception desk at 10 a.m. We will have about a 90-minute tour with a docent and then additional time to roam the museum and the guest shop. Currently, the museum has a special exhibit of paintings and sculptures which depict the exploration of the West by the Lewis and Clark Expedition.

Price: The normal price for military and seniors is \$11, but we will receive an additional \$1 discount. No advance payment required. Pay at the door. And you can apply your ticket price to an annual membership giving you free admission for a year. Annual membership is only \$25, so a couple can get that membership for just \$5 more than the \$20 individual ticket price.

Following the Tour: Join us for an optional no host lunch at nearby Café Forte, 7032 E. Main St. Great food and great reviews, less than a block away.

Activity #2

Diamondbacks vs Reds

Spend a Sunday afternoon at air-conditioned Chase Field on Sunday, August 9, as the Arizona Diamondbacks play the Cincinnati Reds.

We'll sit together as a group in good seats on the second level and get a military discount price of \$24 per ticket.


The Diamondbacks are led by slugging All Star First Baseman Paul Goldschmidt and feature a host of young players who approach the game with enthusiasm and energy.

The Reds have their own slugger at first base, Joey Votto, and closer Aroldis Chapman with the 100 MPH fastball.

The game starts at 1:10 p.m., early enough so you won't have to drive home in the dark.
