"10 Days in North Korea 2015" **Frank Hoak, CAPT, USN (Ret)**

"The fabric of North Korea is woven by the indoctrination of the citizens from childhood into the power of weapons and how having them and showing them protects them from the outside world.

We'll look at censorship of visitors and the practical side of entering the country and behavior while there".



Frank Hoak is an accomplished writer with published works in Naval History and with over 40 years experience in operational intelligence including management and field work assignments in investigations, interrogations, survival training, evasion techniques, resistance, escape, photographic and human intelligence. He is a worldwide traveler and noted public speaker on travel (specializing in the Pacific Ocean areas) and United States Naval History.

Frank Hoak began his Naval career as an enlisted man in 1955 and was later commissioned in 1960. He was the Executive Officer of Naval Investigative Service Office Unit 0893, NAS Willow Grove, PA and later served as the Commanding Officer of the Fleet Intelligence Rapid Support Team Europe & Atlantic 0593 which participated in background investigations of domestic and international personnel at the same Naval Station.

Frank retired as Captain (O-6) with 29 years of service in 1984.
