Minutes of the April 16, 2016 Arizona Chapter of MOAA General Meeting

The April 2016 meeting and luncheon of the general membership of the Arizona Chapter of MOAA was held on Saturday, April 16 2016 at McCormick Ranch Golf Club, Scottsdale Arizona.

Dave Fleming opened the meeting at 11:45 AM with the Pledge of Allegiance followed by an invocation.

Members present: 57 people attended the luncheon today, and all guests were recognized. New member CDR Bill Pedene USN Ret and his wife Paul were introduced.

Lunch was served and enjoyed by all.

Treasurer's report: Charlie Bitner, Treasurer, reported the Scholarship Fund is currently at \$14,128, General Fund at \$8,400 including \$200 in petty cash for making change for raffle tickets & lunch, for a total of \$22,528. The raffle took in \$120 today with 3 \$20 winners. One winner returned the prize to the scholarship fund so the total for the day is \$80 to the Scholarship Fund.

President's Announcements and Special Presentation:

President Dave Fleming reminded the attendees that this is scholarship month. He then called Rob Welch, Chairman of the scholarship committee, forward and presented him with the MOAA Leadership Award for his long service to the chapter. Rob Welch reviewed the ROTC Scholarship awards that would be presented today.

Dave Fleming announced that he and his wife are moving to Florida soon and so he is stepping down as the Arizona MOAA Chapter President. First Vice-President Lee Lange has accepted the position of President and will be sworn in at the end of this meeting. Ron Bright will become 1st Vice-President and Bruce Kosaveach will become 2nd Vice-President.

The attendees were reminded that the Chapter Golf Tournament will be held this Thursday, April 21st at the Stone Creek Golf Course and all that are not golfers are urged to join the group for lunch.

Jack Farley discussed the new raffle that is being developed as the annual fund raiser for the Chapter. He received a gift of an artificial Putting Green installed as an item for the raffle.
