Minutes of the May 20, 2017 Arizona Chapter of MOAA General Meeting

President's Announcements:

- The fund raising goal for the Scholarship fund this year was \$10,000 and to date the Chapter has raised \$13,000.

Jim Cullison was given a thank you for his efforts as editor of the Newsletter. In addition, the Chapter was awarded a 5 star award for its Website. A thank you applause was given to Rob Welch as our Webmaster.
- During the summer break some of the club members will attend a Diamondbacks-Cincinnati Reds baseball game at Chase Field on July 9th thanks to the efforts of Jim Cullison.
- The next Chapter meeting will be held on September 16, 2017.

Treasurer's report: Charlie Bitner, Treasurer, reported the Scholarship Fund is currently at \$24,735.97. General Fund at \$6,940.40 including \$200 in petty cash for making change for raffle tickets & lunch, for a total of \$31,876.37. Note that the report reflects balances after this year's scholarship money has been taken out of the fund. The raffle grossed \$180 and \$75 was awarded in prizes. There were 63 attendees at the May meeting.

Program: Program Chairman Bruce Kosaveach introduced the Program Speaker, U.S. Representative David Schweikert, (R-AZ-6) Congressman Schweikert led a lively discussion on the current status of health care and tax reform activities in Congress. He then answered many questions.
