Additional recognition was given to Tom Sheets, Pete Berger and Carole Litten for publication of their stories in the 20th Anniversary edition of the 'Since You Asked' produced by the Veteran's Heritage Project. Bruce asked that all members who have had their story already published to stand for recognition.

Bruce thanked Donna Bright for successfully reserving a ramada at McCormick Ranch for our MOAA chapter's October opening.

Bruce kicked off our 2024 Annual ROTC Scholarship fund raising campaign. Tom Sheets kicked off the campaign with a \$100 donation.

Bruce then talked about MOAA's AIA (Advocacy in Action) program where National MOAA representatives visit every senate and congressional representative on the hill championing this year's advocacy issues.
